## CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION WEEK ENDING SEPTEMBER 6, 2020

**AGRICULTURAL SUMMARY:** By the end of the week, 92 percent of cotton crop had reached the bolls opening stage compared with 66 percent last year, according to the Mountain Regional Field Office of the National Agricultural Statistics Service, USDA. Eighteen percent had been defoliated compared with 18 percent last year, and 1 percent had been harvested compared with 1 percent last year Cotton conditions were rated mostly good to excellent. Alfalfa conditions were rated mostly good to excellent, depending on location last week with harvesting taking place on more than three-quarters of the alfalfa acreage across the state. Statewide, pasture and range conditions were rated mostly poor to very poor. No exceptional drought was reported during the week in Arizona, but severe to extreme dryness and extremely high temperatures have affected forage growth in the entire state. In the north central part of the state, new forage growth has been non-existent. In the south and eastern part of the state, some spotty rain was reported, but soil is still extremely dry.
