CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION WEEK ENDING MARCH 28, 2021 (Revised)

AGRICULTURAL SUMMARY: By the end of the week, 35 percent of Durum wheat has headed compared with 34 percent last year, according to the Mountain Regional Field Office of the National Agricultural Statistics Service, USDA. Durum wheat conditions were rated mostly good to excellent. Fifty-six percent of barley has headed compared with 52 percent last year. Barley conditions were rated mostly good to fair. Alfalfa conditions were rated mostly excellent to good depending on location last week, with harvesting taking place on over three-quarters of the alfalfa acreage across the state. For the entire state, pasture and range conditions were rated mostly very poor to poor. Abnormal to exceptional dryness in the entire state continues to affect pasture and range conditions, forage growth, and stock tanks. Some forage growth improvement was reported in the north central and northwestern part of the state. The northwestern and north central part of the state received the most precipitation last week, but it was still not enough to improve pasture and range conditions. The southwestern part of the state recorded the highest temperatures during the week.
