CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION WEEK ENDING JULY 18, 2021

AGRICULTURAL SUMMARY: By the end of the week, 99 percent of the cotton crop had squared compared to 100 percent last year, 72 percent has reached the setting bolls stage compared to 71 percent last year, and 5 percent has reached the bolls opening stage compared to 11 percent last year, according to the Mountain Regional Field Office of the National Agricultural Statistics Service, USDA. Cotton conditions were rated mostly good to excellent. Alfalfa conditions were rated mostly excellent to good depending on location last week, with harvesting taking place on over three-quarters of the alfalfa acreage across the state. For the entire state, pasture and range conditions were rated mostly very poor. Moderate to exceptional drought covers 99 percent of the state, according to the United States Drought Monitor, and continues to affect pasture and range conditions and forage growth. In the north central and northwestern part of the state, some rainfall was reported, but not enough to improve forage growth. Monsoon rains have been more consistent in the south central part of the state and have helped improve crop conditions.
