CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION WEEK ENDING AUGUST 28, 2022

AGRICULTURAL SUMMARY: By August 28, 97 percent of the cotton crop had reached the setting bolls stage, compared with 100 percent last year, and 55 percent had reached the bolls opening stage, compared with 74 percent last year, according to the Mountain Regional Field Office of the National Agricultural Statistics Service, USDA. Cotton conditions were rated mostly good to excellent. Alfalfa conditions were also rated mostly excellent to good, depending on location last week, with harvest taking place on more than three-quarters of the alfalfa acreage across the State. Statewide, pasture and range conditions were rated mostly fair to good. Severe drought remained over 29 percent of the State, compared to 34 percent last week, based on the U.S. Drought Monitor's indications. In the western part of the state, operators continue to reduce water usage to conserve irrigation water needed for the upcoming planting season. Monsoon rains have improved irrigation supplies in some areas but has affected hay harvested in other areas. In the southern part of the state, rains have improved pasture conditions.
