CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION WEEK ENDING OCTOBER 16, 2022

AGRICULTURAL SUMMARY: By October 16, 33 percent of the cotton crop had been harvested, compared with 31 percent last year, according to the Mountain Regional Field Office of the National Agricultural Statistics Service, USDA. Cotton conditions were rated mostly excellent to good. Alfalfa conditions were also rated mostly excellent to good, depending on location last week, with harvest taking place on more than three-quarters of the alfalfa acreage across the State. Statewide, pasture and range conditions were rated mostly fair to good. Range conditions have declined and forage growth has been affected, mostly in the northeastern part of the State. Rainfall was reported throughout the eastern and southern part of the State. Severe drought remained over 18.4 percent of the State compared with 18.3 percent last week. There were no areas of extreme or exceptional drought, based on the U.S. Drought Monitor's indications. Monsoonal rains continue in the south-central part of the State. Livestock have been moved from federal grazing land to private or permitted land in the northeastern part of the State. The lowest temperatures were reported in the north central part of the State, but were still over 50 degrees Fahrenheit.
