## CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION WEEK ENDING NOVEMBER 13, 2022

**AGRICULTURAL SUMMARY:** By November 13, 53 percent of the cotton crop had been harvested, compared with 57 percent last year, according to the Mountain Regional Field Office of the National Agricultural Statistics Service, USDA. Alfalfa conditions were also rated mostly good to excellent, depending on location last week, with harvest taking place on more than three-quarters of the alfalfa acreage across the State. Statewide, pasture and range conditions were rated mostly fair. In the northeastern part of the State, producers were wrapping up grass hay and cattle forage crops for the season. Livestock have been moved onto winter ranges. Severe drought remained across 12.8 percent of the State. There were no areas of extreme or exceptional drought, based on the U.S. Drought Monitor's indications. At least 1.5 inches of precipitation was reported in the north central and northwestern parts of the State, based on NOAA's data. Average temperatures were below normal across much of the State, with overnight lows falling below 25 degrees for a widespread portion of several northern counties.
