WEATHER

Temperature lows for California ranged from mid 10s to low 50s in the mountains, mid 20s to low 60s in the desert, mid 30s to low 60s along the coast, and mid 30s to high 50s in the valley. Temperature highs for the state ranged from low 40s to low 80s in the mountains, mid 50s to low 90s along the coast, high 50s to low 90s in the desert, and high 60s to low 90s in the valley.

FIELD CROPS

Across the Central Valley, **alfalfa** hay production was winding down and quality test results were variable. **Corn** silage harvest neared completion. Groundwork continued in preparation for fall and winter plantings. In the Sacramento Valley, **rice** harvest continued. Some growers reported they did not purchase water for their final cutting of alfalfa due to high water costs. In the San Joaquin Valley, **cotton** defoliation was ramping up. Cotton harvest was slow as producers waited for the top bolls to open. Modules were stored in fields and trucked to gin yards. A few gins were operating and a couple gin breakdowns were reported. In Stanislaus County, **dry beans** continued to be cut and dried. In Tulare County, some corn fields for silage and some alfalfa fields remained to be harvested. Fields were leveled and prepped for winter grain planting. In Imperial County, strong winds dried some hay on the ground.

FRUIT CROPS

Stone fruit harvest was nearing completion. Hand pruning continued where necessary. **Prune**, **pear**, and **nectarine** harvests continued to wind down for the season. Late-variety **peach** and **plum** harvests were ongoing in Tulare County. **Kiwifruit** and **pomegranate** harvests were steady. **Grape** harvest was still taking place by a few producers. Grapes that weren't harvested were covered with plastic to protect against the heavy winds. Valencia **orange** and **grapefruit** harvests continued. **Lemon** and **lime** harvest began. Citrus groves were pruned, fertilized, and sprayed to control weeds. **Olive** harvest was ongoing. **Strawberries** were harvested.

NUT CROPS

Walnut and pistachio harvests were strong and steady.

VEGETABLE CROPS

Across the state, **winter squash** were harvested. In San Mateo County, **brussels sprouts**, **tomatoes**, **lettuce**, and **peppers** were harvested. **Pumpkin** harvest continued. In Siskiyou County, **carrots** and **onions** were harvested. In Tulare County, pumpkins were harvested and sold at roadside stands. Some heirloom tomatoes, **eggplants**, and hot peppers were harvested. Harvest of summer vegetables neared completion.

LIVESTOCK

Rangeland and non-irrigated pasture continued to be in very poor condition, despite light rains in some locations. Irrigated pasture remained in good to excellent condition. Supplemental feeding and watering of cattle was ongoing. As the first snow fell in the mountains, cattle continued to be moved down from higher elevation range in preparation for winter. Sheep grazed on retired cropland and harvested grain fields. Beekeepers provided supplemental pollen and began preparing hives for overwintering.
