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The inventory, production, slaughter, utilization, monthly and annual average price, and livestock value statistics for Florida are official State and USDA estimates prepared by the Crop and Livestock Reporting Service. Corresponding data for other livestock producing States are from official reports of the USDA National Agricultural Statistics Service, (formerly Statistical Reporting Service). Information on shipments, auction market prices, and special feeder sales are from cooperative work between the Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, Livestock Market News Section and the Divisions of Inspection and Animal Industry, and the USDA's Market News Branch, Agricultural Marketing Service.

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## LIVESTOCK SUMMARY

### Cattle and calves

Florida's January 1, 1986 inventory of all cattle and calves totaled 2,120,000 head, down 3 percent from 1985. Florida ranked 15th in the Nation. Nationally, the inventory of 105.5 million head was down 4 percent. The decline continues the recent downward trend in cattle inventories begun three years ago.

Florida's beef cow herd, which decreased 2 percent from last year, totaled 1,135,000 head. Florida continues to rank 1st in beef cows in all States east of the Mississippi River and 9th nationally.

Feeder calves shipped out of Florida by truck from areas east and south of the Suwannee River during 1985 totaled nearly 455,000, up 4 percent from 1984. Texas, Oklahoma, California, Mississippi, and Alabama received 88 percent of the feeder calf outshipments. Rounding out the top 10 States were Kansas, Georgia, Arizona, New Mexico, and Missouri, in that order, with 9 percent of the total.

Cattle in Florida feedlots on January 1, 1986 totaled 65,000 head, down 28 percent from January 1, 1985.

### Hogs on farms

The December 1, 1985 Florida inventory of hogs and pigs was estimated at 158,000 head, one percent less than a year earlier. The breeding hog inventory was up 4 percent while the inventory for market was down 2 percent.

### Cash receipts

Cash receipts from cattle and calves marketed by Florida cattle producers during 1985 totaled \$332,412,000, down 11 percent from 1984. Total pounds marketed were 10 percent below 1984 and accounted for most of the decrease in receipts. Calf prices were up \$1.90 per cwt, but cattle prices were down \$2.50 from a year earlier.

Cash receipts from hog marketings totaled \$17,950,000, down 34 percent from 1984. A sharp drop in marketings and lower prices contributed to the decrease. Marketings were down 32 percent and price was off by \$1.40 per cwt from the previous year.

### Bees and honey

Because of budgetary restraints, the bee and honey estimating program was dropped in 1982. Only historical data are included in this summary. Beginning in December 1986, bee and honey estimates will be reinstated.

### Sheep and lambs

Florida estimates for sheep and lambs were discontinued after January 1978.

### Survey methodology

Primary data used in making cattle inventory estimates in this summary were obtained from probability surveys. Nationally, these surveys include approximately 70,000 farming operations heavily weighted to include operations having cattle. Information is collected by mail, telephone and personal interviews. Since all operations with cattle are not included in the sample, survey estimates are subject to sampling variability. This variability, as measured by the relative standard error, is about one percent at the national level for cattle inventory. This means that chances are approximately 95 out of 100 that a survey estimate will be within two percent of the complete coverage value if the same procedures were used to survey all producers. In Florida, approximately 1,400 cattle producers were surveyed with most of the large farms and ranches included in the count. As would be expected, the relative standard error for Florida and other states is greater than at the national level because of the smaller number of farms in the state samples.

Survey estimates are also subject to non-sampling errors such as omissions, duplications, recording and processing the data and mistakes in reporting. These errors cannot be measured directly, but they are minimized through rigid quality controls on the data collection process and a careful review of all reported data.

In setting the inventory estimates, survey information on births and deaths is used as well as inventory numbers. The survey results are combined with reliable data from other sources for slaughter, imports and exports to construct national and state balance sheets, which provide an additional check on survey inventory estimates.
