## 2011 Georgia Vegetable Production

- **Snap Beans** – Georgia Snap Bean Production up 11% from 2010
- **Cabbage** – Georgia Cabbage Production down 28% from 2010
- **Cantaloupes** – Georgia Cantaloupe Production down 31% from 2010
- **Sweet Corn** – Georgia Sweet Corn Production down 31% from 2010
- **Cucumbers** – Georgia Cucumbers Production down 40% from 2010
- **Onions** – Georgia Onions Production up 30% from 2010
- **Bell Peppers** – Georgia Bell Peppers Production up 65% from 2010
- **Squash** – Georgia Squash Production down 3% from 2010
- **Watermelon** – Georgia Watermelon Production down 36% from 2010
