2007 IDAHO BARLEY VARIETIES


Idaho's leading variety for the thirteenth consecutive year was Harrington, a malting variety. Harrington accounted for 18.4 percent of all barley planted and nearly 27 percent of the total malting variety acres. The leading feed variety was Baronesse, accounting for 12.1 percent of all barley planted. Baronesse accounted for 39 percent of the feed variety acres.

Malting Varieties: Malting varieties accounted for 69 percent of all barley acres in 2007, down 6 percentage points from the record 75 percent set last year. The leading malting variety was Harrington, accounting for 18.4 percent of all barley acres, down 9.5 percentage points from last year. The second largest malting variety was AC Metcalfe with 15.9 percent of the acreage. Merit (B4947) was third with 9.7

percent, Conrad (B5057) was fourth with 8.0 percent and Moravian 69 (C69) was fifth with 7.5 percent of all barley acres.

Feed Varieties: Feed varieties accounted for 31 percent of all barley acres in 2007, up 6 percentage points from last year's 25 percent. Baronesse continues to be the leading feed variety, accounting for 12.1 percent of all barley acres, up 3.0 percentage points from a year ago. Camas is the second largest feed variety with 2.2 percent of the barley acreage followed by Spaulding with 1.8 percent of the acres. Gallatin is fourth with 1.7 percent and Xena is the fifth largest feed variety with 1.6 percent of all barley acres planted.


