## 2000 IDAHO BARLEY VARIETIES



Harrington remained Idaho's number one barley variety for the sixth consecutive year, accounting for 22.3 percent of all barley planted. Baronesse was second, accounting for 17.1 percent of the state's acreage. Other top five varieties included: B1202, third with 10.8 percent; Morex, fourth with 10.0 percent; and Galena (C10), fifth with 6.2 percent.

Malting Varieties: Malting barley accounted for 61.3 percent of the total barley acres planted, up from 56.3 percent recorded in 1999. Harrington, with 167,600 acres planted, was the leading variety again this year. B1202 remained second with 81,300 acres planted, accounting for

10.8 percent of all plantings. Morex was third, with 75,000 acres and 10.0 percent. Galena (C10) was fourth with 46,700 acres and 6.2 percent. In fifth place was Merit (B4947) with 31,700 acres and 4.2 percent.

Feed Varieties: Baronesse continued to be the leading feed variety with 128,100 acres planted. Steptoe was second with 23,000 acres and 3.1 percent. Hector was third, with 16,900 acres and 2.3 percent. Gallatin was fourth with 15,300 acres and 2.0 percent. Colter was fifth, with 11,800 acres and 1.6 percent.
