Christian Co Information

Christian County is a county located in the state of Illinois. As of 2000, the population is 35,372. The County was formed in 1839 out of Sangamon, Montgomery and Shelby Counties. Its county seat is Taylorville, Illinois.

The County was originally called "Dane County", but the name was changed in 1840, when it was renamed for Christian County, Kentucky, and for Col. William Christian, a native of Augusta County, Virginia, and a veteran of the Revolutionary War, killed by Native Americans in southern Indiana in 1786.

Christian Co Geography

According to the U.S. Census Bureau, the county has a total area of 1,854 km (716 mi). 1,836 km (709 mi) of it is land and 17 km (7 mi) of it is water. The total area is 0.93% water.
