## COUNTY ESTIMATES FOR 2007 NOW AVAILABLE

The official estimates of acreage, yield and production of corn, soybeans and wheat for counties in Illinois for 2007 have been released by the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service, Illinois Field Office. 



# 2007 Illinois Corn Yield




