

HOG SLAUGHTER

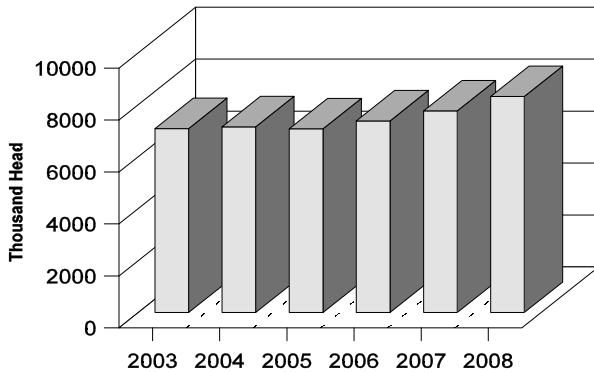
Slaughter production for hogs during 2008 in Indiana totaled 2.18 billion pounds, an increase of 7 percent from the 2007 figure of 2.03 billion pounds. There were 8.32 million hogs slaughtered, up 7 percent from 2007. The average weight per hog, at 262 pounds, was unchanged from 2007.

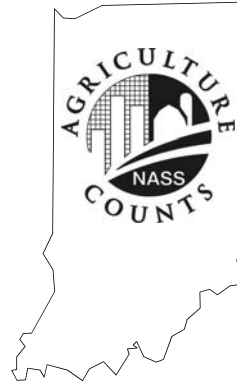

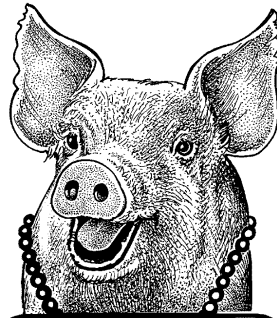
COMMERCIAL HOG SLAUGHTER
