OPERATION TYPES

An **Equine Operation** is defined as any place that has at least one resident equine. There are 160,000 total equine located on a total of 34,000 operations. These operations are categorized based upon these specific uses:


1,000 **Racing Operations** with at least one horse that was kept primarily for the intention of racing whether or not a parimutuel event. The 10,360 total equine on these operations consist of 6,800 race horses and 3,560 foals, mares, stallions and other equine located on the operation but primarily used for purposes other than racing.

6,120 **Show or Competition Operations** without any race horses, and had at least one equine that was primarily used for showing, polo, eventing, etc. The 38,970 total equine on these operations consist of 23,220 show or competition equine and 15,750 equine used for other purposes.

4,850 **Work Operations** that used equine for work, hauling, or transportation and not racing, showing or competing. The 26,470 total equine consist of 17,290 work horses and 9,180 equine used for other


22,030 **Trail or Recreation and Other Operations** which are not included in the above groups and have 84,200 total equine used for pleasure, trail riding, hunting, pleasure driving, breeding, teaching, 4-H and other youth programs, commercial carriage rides, police patrols, and any retired horses.
