CATTLE AND DAIRY PRODUCTS

The total live weight of cattle and calves marketed during 2000 was increased 9 percent from a year earlier. The average price for cattle increased \$3.00 per cwt. to \$57.10. Calf prices for 2000 averaged \$95.00 per cwt. compared with \$77.10 during 1999. Cash receipts totaled \$239 million, up 19 percent from the \$201 million a year earlier. Gross income (cash receipts plus value of home consumption) increased 18 percent from a year earlier.
