## SHEEP AND LAMBS

The number of sheep and lambs marketed during 2000 increased 9 percent to 47,500 head. The total pounds of sheep and lambs marketed was 4 percent above the 1999 level. Cash receipts totaled $\$ 2.6$ million, up 16 percent from $\$ 2.3$ million in 1999. Gross income (cash receipts plus value of home consumption) totaled $\$ 3.0$ million in 2000 compared with $\$ 2.6$ million a year earlier. Sheep averaged $\$ 35.40$ per cwt. and lambs averaged $\$ 73.80$ per cwt. during 2000.

Lambs saved in 2000, at 63,000 head, was up 19 percent from the previous year. The number of ewes one year old and older on hand January 1, 2001 was up 18 percent from 2000. Lamb crop per 100 ewes one year old and older was 166 during 2000, up 10 percent from a year earlier.

Wool production increased 13 percent during 2000 to 385,000 pounds. Sheep and lambs shorn totaled 61,000 head with an average fleece weight of 6.3 pounds. Total value of shorn wool was $\$ 54,000$, up 13 percent from a year earlier and averaging 14 cents per pound.
