CATTLE AND DAIRY PRODUCTS

The total live weight of cattle and calves marketed during 1998 decreased 26 percent from a year earlier. The average price for cattle decreased \$4.50 per cwt. to \$51.30. Calf prices for 1998 averaged \$70.90 per cwt. compared with \$75.30 during 1997. Cash receipts totaled \$190 million, down 31 percent from the \$277 million a year earlier. Gross income (cash receipts plus value of home consumption) decreased 30 percent from a year earlier.
