May 1 Cattle on Feed

Iowa: There were 920,000 cattle on feed for the slaughter market in all feedlots in Iowa on May 1, 2005, down 2 percent from April 1, 2005 and down 7 percent from May 1, 2004. Feedlots with a capacity greater than 1,000 head had 455,000 head on feed, unchanged from last month, but up 10 percent from last year. Feedlots with a capacity less than 1,000 head had 465,000 head on feed, down 4 percent and 18 percent from last month and last year, respectively.

Placements during April totaled 92,000 head, unchanged from last month, but down 10 percent from last year. Feedlots with a capacity greater than 1,000 head placed 55,000 head, unchanged from last month, but down 4 percent from last year. Feedlots with a capacity

less than 1,000 head placed 37,000 head, unchanged from last month, but down 18 percent from last year.

Marketings for April were 102,000 head, down 1 percent and 4 percent from last month and last year, respectively. Feedlots with a capacity greater than 1,000 head marketed 53,000 head, down 17 percent from last year, but unchanged from a year ago. Feedlots with a capacity less than 1,000 head marketed 49,000 head, up 26 percent from last month, but down 8 percent from last year. Other disappearance totaled 10,000 head.
