KANSAS CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

MANHATTAN, Kan. January 29, 2024 - For the week ending January 28, 2024, topsoil moisture supplies rated 4% very short, 16% short, 65% adequate, and 15% surplus, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 11% very short, 32% short, 49% adequate, and 8% surplus.

Field Crops Report: Winter wheat condition rated 4% very poor, 11% poor, 31% fair, 46% good, and 8% excellent.

The next report will be issued February 26, 2024.
