KANSAS HEMP ACREAGE

MANHATTAN, Kan. April 19, 2023 – Industrial hemp grown in open areas in Kansas in 2022 totaled 980 acres, up 81% from 2021, according to the USDA’s National Agricultural Statistics Service. Industrial hemp harvested in open areas totaled 530 acres, up 33% from last year. Industrial hemp grown under protection in Kansas totaled 86,219 square feet, an increase from 75,334 square feet last year.
