2023 KANSAS SMALL GRAIN ACREAGE AND PRODUCTION

MANHATTAN, Kan. September 29, 2023 - Winter wheat production is estimated at 201 million bushels, down 18% from last year, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. The area harvested for grain totaled 5.75 million acres, down 13% from 2022. Planted acreage totaled 8.10 million acres, up 11% from a year earlier. The yield is 35.0 bushels per acre, down 2.0 bushels from 2022.

Out production is estimated at 1.98 million bushels, up 93% from 2022. Area harvested for grain, at 30,000 acres, is up 20% from last year. Planted acreage totaled 185,000 acres, up 68% from a year earlier. Yield is 66.0 bushels per acre, up 25.0 bushels per acre from last year.

Barley production is estimated at 145,000 bushels, down 12% from a year ago. Area harvested for grain is 5,000 acres, unchanged from 2022. Planted acreage totaled 16,000 acres, up 7% from last year. Average yield, at 29.0 bushels per acre, is down 4.0 bushels from 2022.
