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### KANSAS RANKED 6TH IN AGRICULTURAL EXPORTS

Kansas ranked sixth among the 50 states as an exporter of agricultural products during fiscal year (FY) 2006, according to data compiled by the Economics Research Service using data from National Agricultural Statistics Service, and Census Bureau, U.S. Department of Commerce. Exports from seven out of the top ten states increased. The total value of Kansas exports, at \$3.2 billion, is up 16 percent from the previous fiscal year and is the second highest since 1973. Most of the value increase came from the Wheat & Products and Live Animals & Meat categories. Kansas accounted for 4.7 percent of the \$68.7 billion U.S. agricultural exports in FY 2006.

Kansas ranked first in the Nation for Wheat & Products, Feed & Fodders, and Hides & Skins. The export numbers show Kansas ranking second in Animal Fats. Other top ten rankings for Kansas were Live Animals & Meat (third place with \$449.8 million,) Sunflower Seed & Oil (third place with \$15.0 million), Seed (fifth place with \$38.3 million), and Feed Grains & Products (sixth place with \$557.6 million). Wheat & Products accounted for 28 percent of the State total and 15 percent of the National All Wheat & Products exports. Feed Grains & Products comprised 17 percent of the total Kansas exports and 6 percent of all U.S. Feed Grains & Products exports. Feed & Fodders tallied 14 and 8 percent of the State and National exports, respectively.

### U.S. AGRICULTURAL EXPORTS UP 10 PERCENT

The United States exported \$68.7 billion of agricultural commodities in FY 2006, up 10 percent from 2005. California continued to lead the Nation in agricultural exports at \$10.5 billion. Iowa ranked second, followed by Texas, Illinois, Nebraska, Kansas, Minnesota, Washington, North Carolina, and Indiana. Agricultural export estimates by State are based on the assumption that if a State contributes a certain percentage of U.S. production, it contributes a similar percentage of export revenues. When appropriate, however, supplemental data (Customs district data, domestic use data, and the Census of Agriculture data, for example) were used to adjust the export share.
