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KANSAS: The June **All Farm Products Index** of Prices Received by Kansas farmers, at 104 percent of the 1990-92 base, was up 1 point from May 2003 and up 13 points from June 2002. The **All Crops Index** in June, at 107 percent of the 1990-92 base, was down 5 points from May but up 3 points from 2002. The **Meat Animals Index**, at 102 percent of the 1990-92 base, was up 1 point from May and 17 points above last year. More detailed information regarding price indexes is shown in the first table on the back of this release.

Wheat prices in mid-June, at \$3.01 per bushel, were down 25 cents from May but 3 cents above last June.

Corn prices in mid-June, at \$2.44 per bushel, were down 7 cents from May but 38 cents above last June.

Farmers received an average of \$3.69 per cwt. for **grain sorghum** in mid-June, down 21 cents from May but 47 cents above last June.

Soybean prices, at \$5.95 per bushel in mid-June, were down 9 cents from May but \$1.19 above last June.

All hay prices averaged \$72.00 per ton in mid-June, down \$5.00 from May and \$13.00 lower than last year. **Alfalfa hay** averaged \$74.00 per ton, down \$4.00 from May and \$13.00 lower than last June. **Other hay**, at \$59.00 per ton, was down \$6.00 from May and \$10.00 below last June.

All beef cattle were bringing an average of \$78.20 per

cwt. in mid-June, up 50 cents from May and \$13.30 above the price last June. **Cow** prices, at \$43.10 per cwt., were up 40 cents from May and \$3.90 above the price last June. **Steers and heifers** averaged \$78.60 per cwt., down 60 cents from May but \$13.40 above June 2002. **Calf** prices in mid-June were \$102.00 per cwt., down \$1.00 from May but up \$5.00 from June 2002.

The **all hog** price of \$43.00 per cwt. for mid-June was up \$3.50 from May and up \$9.60 from last June. **Sow** prices averaged \$29.50, up 90 cents from May and \$8.40 higher than June 2002. **Barrow and gilt** prices averaged \$45.00 per cwt. in mid-June, up \$3.70 from May and \$9.80 above last June.

May **lamb** prices were \$97.00 per cwt. **Sheep** prices averaged \$28.00 per cwt. in May.

UNITED STATES: The **All Farm Products Index** of Prices Received in June was 106 percent of the 1990-92 base, unchanged from May but 8 points above June 2002.

The June **All Crops Index** was 114, down 3 points from May but 8 points above June 2002.

The June **Livestock and Products Index**, at 99, was up 2 points from last month and up 9 points from June 2002.
