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KANSAS: The June **All Farm Products Index** of Prices Received by Kansas farmers, at 119 percent of the 1990-92 base, was down 1 point from May but up 17 points from June 2003. The **All Crops Index** in June, at 124 percent of the 1990-92 base, was down 17 points from May but up 21 points from 2003. The **Meat Animals Index**, at 117 percent of the 1990-92 base, was up 1 point from May and 16 points above last year. More detailed information regarding price indexes is shown in the first table on the back of this release.

Wheat prices in mid-June, at \$3.46 per bushel, were down 30 cents from May but 62 cents above last June.

Corn prices in mid-June, at \$2.82 per bushel, were down 15 cents from May but 40 cents above last June.

Farmers received an average of \$4.34 per cwt. for **grain sorghum** in mid-June, down 34 cents from May but 76 cents above last June.

Soybean prices, at \$8.52 per bushel in mid-June, were down \$1.27 from May but \$2.26 above last June.

All hay prices averaged \$71.00 per ton in mid-June, down \$2.00 from May and \$1.00 lower than last year. **Alfalfa hay** averaged \$79.00 per ton, down \$2.00 from May but \$5.00 higher than last June. **Other hay**, at \$58.00 per ton, was up \$2.00 from May but \$1.00 below last June.

All beef cattle were bringing an average of \$89.00 per

cwt. in mid-June, up 50 cents from May and \$11.90 above the price last June. **Cow** prices, at \$52.20 per cwt., were up 50 cents from May and \$8.50 above the price last June. **Steers and heifers** averaged \$89.40 per cwt., down 60 cents from May but \$12.00 above June 2003. **Calf** prices in mid-June were \$132.00 per cwt., up \$5.00 from May and up \$27.00 from June 2003.

The **all hog** price of \$51.90 per cwt. for mid-June was down \$1.50 from May but up \$9.00 from last June. **Sow** prices averaged \$44.30, unchanged from May but \$13.80 higher than June 2003. **Barrow and gilt** prices averaged \$53.00 per cwt. in mid-June, down \$1.90 from May but \$8.30 above last June.

May **lamb** prices were \$100.00 per cwt. **Sheep** prices averaged \$33.00 per cwt. in May.

UNITED STATES: The **All Farm Products Index** of Prices Received in June was 129 percent of the 1990-92 base, unchanged from May but 22 points above June 2003.

The June **All Crops Index** was 123, down 1 point from May but 5 points above June 2003.

The June **Livestock and Products Index**, at 133, was unchanged from last month but up 34 points from June 2003.
