**KANSAS:** The January **All Farm Products Index** of Prices Received by Kansas farmers, at 105 percent of the 1990-92 base, was up 4 points from December but down 4 points from January 2004. The **All Crops Index** in January, at 92 percent of the 1990-92 base, was down 2 points from December and down 31 points from 2004. The **Meat Animals Index**, at 116 percent of the 1990-92 base, was up 2 points from December and 12 points above last year. More detailed information regarding price indexes is shown in the first table on the back of this release.

**Wheat** prices in mid-January, at \$3.28 per bushel, were up 1 cent from December but 39 cents below last January.

**Corn** prices in mid-January, at \$1.84 per bushel, were down 17 cents from December and 79 cents below last January.

Farmers received an average of \$2.77 per cwt. for **sorghum grain** in mid-January, down 7 cents from December and \$1.57 below last January.

**Soybean** prices, at \$4.92 per bushel in mid-January, were down 12 cents from December and \$2.88 below last January.

**All hay** prices averaged \$62.00 per ton in mid-January, up \$1.00 from December but \$3.00 lower than last year. **Alfalfa hay** averaged \$69.00 per ton, down \$2.00 from December and \$5.00 lower than last January. **Other hay**, at \$50.00 per ton, was up \$1.00 from December but \$4.00 below last January.

**All beef cattle** were bringing an average of \$88.80 per

cwt. in mid-January, up \$1.60 from December and \$8.50 above the price last January. **Cow** prices, at \$51.20 per cwt., were up \$3.00 from December and \$4.80 above the price last January. **Steers and heifers** averaged \$90.40 per cwt., up \$2.00 from December and \$8.70 above January 2004. **Calf** prices in mid-January were \$127.00 per cwt., down \$6.00 from December but up \$11.00 from January 2004.

The **all hog** price of \$50.20 per cwt. for mid-January was up \$1.40 from December and up \$14.00 from last January. **Sow** prices averaged \$46.30, up \$2.00 from December and \$17.00 higher than January 2004. **Barrow and gilt** prices averaged \$50.80 per cwt. in mid-January, up \$1.40 from December and \$13.60 above last January.

December **lamb** prices were \$97.00 per cwt. **Sheep** prices averaged \$42.00 per cwt. in December.

**UNITED STATES:** The **All Farm Products Index** of Prices Received in January was 110 percent of the 1990-92 base, down 1 point from December and 2 points below January 2004.

The January **All Crops Index** was 100, down 3 points from December and 13 points below from January 2004.

The January **Livestock and Products Index**, at 121, was up 1 point from last month and up 11 points from January 2004.
