Kansas Agricultural Statistics

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KANSAS: The July **All Farm Products Index** of Prices Received by Kansas farmers, at 146 percent of the 1990-92 base, was up 15 points from June and up 19 points from July 2006. The **All Crops Index** in July, at 191 percent of the 1990-92 base, was up 16 points from June and up 35 points from 2006. The **Meat Animals Index**, at 120 percent of the 1990-92 base, was up 1 point from June and 8 points above last year. More detailed information regarding price indexes is shown in the first table on the back of this release.

Wheat prices in mid-July, at \$5.52 per bushel, were up 46 cents from June and up 99 cents from last July.

Corn prices in mid-July, at \$3.46 per bushel, were down 38 cents from June but \$1.11 above last July.

Farmers received an average of \$5.51 per cwt. for **sorghum grain** in mid-July, down 82 cents from June but \$1.54 above last July.

Soybean prices, at \$8.10 per bushel in mid-July, were up 53 cents from June and \$2.61 above last July.

All hay prices averaged \$99.00 per ton in mid-July, down \$10.00 from June but \$3.00 higher than last year. **Alfalfa hay** averaged \$102.00 per ton, down \$11.00 from June and \$2.00 lower than last July. **Other hay**, at \$88.00 per ton, was up \$10.00 from June and \$18.00 above last July.

All beef cattle were bringing an average of \$92.50 per cwt. in mid-July, up \$1.30 from June and \$6.40 above the price from last July. **Cow** prices, at \$54.50 per cwt., were up \$1.40 from June and \$8.80 above the price from last July. **Steers and heifers** averaged \$92.90 per cwt., up \$1.30 from June and \$6.40 above July 2006. **Calf** prices in mid-July were \$129.00 per cwt., up \$1.00 from June but down \$11.00 from July 2006.

The **all hog** price of \$46.60 per cwt. for mid-July was down \$2.10 from June but up 60 cents from last July. **Sow** prices averaged \$36.60, down \$1.10 from June but \$3.80 higher than July 2006. **Barrow and gilt** prices averaged \$48.10 per cwt. in mid-July, down \$2.20 from June but 10 cents above last July.

UNITED STATES: The **All Farm Products Index** of Prices Received in July was 142 percent of the 1990-92 base, up 3 points from June and 25 points above July 2006.

The July **All Crops Index** was 143, up 2 points from June and 20 points above July 2006.

The July **Livestock and Products Index**, at 140, was up 3 points from last month and up 29 points from July 2006.
