**KANSAS:** The June **All Farm Products Index** of Prices Received by Kansas farmers, at 136 percent of the 1990-92 base, was up 11 points from May and up 20 points from June 2006. The **All Crops Index** in June, at 188 percent of the 1990-92 base, was up 31 points from May and up 49 points from 2006. The **Meat Animals Index**, at 121 percent of the 1990-92 base, was down 4 points from May but 9 points above last year. More detailed information regarding price indexes is shown in the first table on the back of this release.

**Wheat** prices in mid-June, at \$5.53 per bushel, were up 77 cents from May and up \$1.29 last June.

**Corn** prices in mid-June, at \$4.07 per bushel, were up 50 cents from May and \$1.90 above last June.

Farmers received an average of \$6.61 per cwt. for **sorghum grain** in mid-June, up 6 cents from May and \$2.91 above last June.

**Soybean** prices, at \$7.53 per bushel in mid-June, were up 48 cents from May and \$2.05 above last June.

**All hay** prices averaged \$109.00 per ton in mid-June, down \$7.00 from May but \$12.00 higher than last year. **Alfalfa hay** averaged \$113.00 per ton, down \$6.00 from May but \$12.00 higher than last June. **Other hay**, at \$78.00 per ton, was down \$6.00 from May but \$13.00 above last June.

**All beef cattle** were bringing an average of \$93.10 per cwt. in mid-June, down \$2.70 from May but \$7.60 above the price from last June. **Cow** prices, at \$52.20 per cwt., were down \$1.50 from May but \$4.90 above the price from last June. **Steers and heifers** averaged \$93.50 per cwt., down \$4.10 from May but \$7.60 above June 2006. **Calf** prices in mid-June were \$129.00 per cwt., up \$2.00 from May but down \$8.00 from June 2006.

The **all hog** price of \$47.50 per cwt. for mid-June was unchanged from May but down \$3.50 from last June. **Sow** prices averaged \$36.60, up \$2.90 from May and \$2.70 higher than June 2006. **Barrow and gilt** prices averaged \$49.10 per cwt. in mid-June, down 50 cents from May and \$4.50 below last June.

Individual commodity prices are shown in the second table on the back of this release.

**UNITED STATES:** The **All Farm Products Index** of Prices Received in June was 141 percent of the 1990-92 base, up 3 points from May and 23 points above June 2006.

The June **All Crops Index** was 146, up 3 points from May and 19 points above June 2006.

The June **Livestock and Products Index**, at 136, was up 2 points from last month and up 26 points from June 2006.
