Kansas Agricultural Statistics

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KANSAS: The September **All Farm Products Index** of Prices Received by Kansas farmers, at 148 percent of the 1990-92 base, was up 10 points from August and up 26 points from September 2006. The **All Crops Index** in September, at 205 percent of the 1990-92 base, was up 12 points from August and up 71 points from 2006. The **Meat Animals Index**, at 126 percent of the 1990-92 base, was up 1 point from August and 5 points above last year. More detailed information regarding price indexes is shown in the first table on the back of this release.

Wheat prices in mid-September, at \$7.46 per bushel, were up \$1.58 from August and up \$2.95 last September.

Corn prices in mid-September, at \$3.31 per bushel, were up 5 cents from August and 88 cents above last September.

Farmers received an average of \$5.69 per cwt. for **sorghum grain** in mid-September, up 9 cents from August and \$1.76 above last September.

Soybean prices, at \$8.49 per bushel in mid-September, were up 61 cents from August and \$3.32 above last September.

All hay prices averaged \$110.00 per ton in mid-September, up \$11.00 from August and \$7.00 higher than last year. **Alfalfa hay** averaged \$115.00 per ton, up \$8.00 from August and \$6.00 higher than last September. **Other hay**, at \$77.00 per ton, was down \$3.00 from August but \$8.00 above last September.

All beef cattle were bringing an average of \$97.50 per cwt. in mid-September, up \$1.70 from August and \$4.10 above the price from last September. **Cow** prices, at \$52.20 per cwt., were down \$2.10 from August but \$4.00 above the price from last September. **Steers and heifers** averaged \$98.40 per cwt., up \$2.20 from August and \$4.10 above September 2006. **Calf** prices in mid-September were \$132.00 per cwt., unchanged from August but down \$5.00 from September 2006.

The **all hog** price of \$41.00 per cwt. for mid-September was down \$4.80 from August and down \$3.80 from last September. **Sow** prices averaged \$36.60, up 90 cents from August but 40 cents lower than September 2006. **Barrow and gilt** prices averaged \$41.70 per cwt. in mid-September, down \$5.60 from August and \$4.30 below last September.

UNITED STATES: The **All Farm Products Index** of Prices Received in September was 142 percent of the 1990-92 base, up 2 points from August and 23 points above September 2006.

The September **All Crops Index** was 144, up 3 points from August and 23 points above September 2006.

The September **Livestock and Products Index**, at 141, was up 2 points from last month and up 25 points from September 2006.
