KANSAS: The January **All Farm Products Index** of Prices Received by Kansas farmers, at 155 percent of the 1990-92 base, was down 3 points from December but up 30 points from January 2007. The **All Crops Index** in January, at 234 percent of the 1990-92 base, was up 24 points from December and up 78 points from 2007. The **Meat Animals Index**, at 119 percent of the 1990-92 base, was up 1 point from December and 6 points above last year. More detailed information regarding price indexes is shown in the first table on the back of this release.

Wheat prices in mid-January, at \$8.84 per bushel, were up 37 cents from December and \$3.94 above last January.

Corn prices in mid-January, at \$4.53 per bushel, were up 54 cents from December and \$1.15 above last January.

Farmers received an average of \$8.24 per cwt. for **sorghum grain** in mid-January, up \$1.41 from December and \$1.85 above last January.

Soybean prices, at \$11.40 per bushel in mid-January, were up \$1.10 from December and \$5.13 above last January.

All hay prices averaged \$99.00 per ton in mid-January, down \$5.00 from December and \$8.00 lower than last year. **Alfalfa hay** averaged \$111.00 per ton, down \$2.00 from December and \$11.00 lower than last January. **Other hay**, at \$78.00 per ton, was down \$2.00 from December and \$2.00 below last January.

All beef cattle were bringing an average of \$92.60 per cwt. in mid-January, down 20 cents from December but \$5.50 above the price last January. **Cow** prices, at \$46.00 per cwt., were unchanged from December but 30 cents above the price last January. **Steers and heifers** averaged \$94.50 per cwt., up 30 cents from December and \$5.70 above January 2007. **Calf** prices in mid-January were \$116.00 per cwt., down \$3.00 from December and down \$2.00 from January 2007.

The **all hog** price of \$29.40 per cwt. for mid-January was down \$3.20 from December and down \$9.30 from last January. **Sow** prices averaged \$20.50, up 40 cents from December but \$10.10 lower than January 2007. **Barrow and gilt** prices averaged \$30.70 per cwt. in mid-January, down \$3.80 December and \$9.20 below last January.

Individual commodity prices are shown in the second table on the back of this release.

UNITED STATES: The **All Farm Products Index** of Prices Received in January was 150 percent of the 1990-92 base, up 6 points from December and 27 points above January 2007.

The January **All Crops Index** was 167, up 16 points from December and 36 points above January 2007.

The January **Livestock and Products Index**, at 132, was down 4 points from last month but up 16 points from January 2007.
