KANSAS: The June **All Farm Products Index** of Prices Received by Kansas farmers, at 169 percent of the 1990-92 base, is up 34 points from May and up 39 points from June 2007. The **All Crops Index** in June, at 294 percent of the 1990-92 base, is up 47 points from May and up 119 points from 2007. The **Meat Animals Index**, at 124 percent of the 1990-92 base, is up 1 point from May and 5 points above last year. More detailed information regarding price indexes is shown in the first table on the back of this release.

Wheat prices in mid-June, at \$8.57 per bushel, is up 42 cents from May and up \$3.51 from last June.

Corn prices in mid-June, at \$6.68 per bushel, is up \$1.02 from May and \$2.79 above last June.

Farmers received an average of \$11.30 per cwt. for **sorghum grain** in mid-June, up \$1.88 from May and \$4.97 above last June.

Soybean prices, at \$14.30 per bushel in mid-June, is up \$1.70 from May and \$6.72 above last June.

All hay prices averaged \$117.00 per ton in mid-June, up \$16.00 from May and \$8.00 higher than last year. **Alfalfa hay** averaged \$124.00 per ton, up \$19.00 from May and \$11.00 higher than last June. **Other hay**, at \$84.00 per ton, is up \$4.00 from May and \$6.00 above last June.

All beef cattle is bringing an average of \$95.50 per cwt. in mid-June, up \$1.40 from May and \$4.30 above the price from last June. **Cow** prices, at \$55.00 per cwt., is down 60 cents from May but \$1.90 above the price from last June. **Steers and heifers** averaged \$95.90 per cwt., up 20 cents from May and \$4.30 above June 2007. **Calf** prices in mid-June is \$123.00 per cwt., up \$2.00 from May but down \$5.00 from June 2007.

The **all hog** price of \$47.30 per cwt. for mid-June is down \$1.10 from May and down \$1.40 from last June. **Sow** prices averaged \$29.50, up \$2.70 from May but \$8.20 lower than June 2007. **Barrow and gilt** prices averaged \$50.00 per cwt. in mid-June, down \$1.60 from May and 30 cents below last June.

Grain and oilseed prices by district are shown in the second table on the back of this release.

UNITED STATES: The **All Farm Products Index** of Prices Received in June is 162 percent of the 1990-92 base, up 11 points from May and 25 points above June 2007.

The June **All Crops Index** is 190, up 19 points from May and 49 points above June 2007.

The June **Livestock and Products Index**, at 137, is up 3 points from last month and June 2007.
