



Kansas Cattle on Feed

The number of **cattle on feed** on September 1, 2005 in Kansas feedlots with 1,000 head or more capacity totaled 2.21 million head, up 4 percent from a year ago and up 1 percent from August 1, 2005. **Placements** during August totaled 520,000 head, unchanged from a year ago but 8 percent above July 2005 placements of 480,000 head. **Marketings** during August totaled 490,000 head, 1 percent below August 2004 but

4 percent above July 2005. **Other disappearance** was 10,000 head, down 5,000 from a year ago and down 10,000 from the previous month. The percent of August placements by weight was: under 600 pounds, 16 percent; 600-699 pounds, 20 percent; 700-799 pounds, 32 percent; and 800 pounds or heavier, 32 percent.

U.S. Cattle on Feed

Cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market in the United States in feedlots with capacity of 1,000 or more head totaled 10.0 million head on September 1, 2005. The inventory was up slightly from the 9.99 million head on September 1, 2004 and 2 percent above September 1, 2003. **Placements** in feedlots during August totaled 1.99 million, 5 percent below 2004 and 16 percent below 2003. Net placements were 1.94 million. During August, placements of cattle and calves weighing less

than 600 pounds were 418,000; 600-699 pounds were 385,000; 700-799 pounds were 540,000; and 800 pounds and greater were 650,000. **Marketings** of fed cattle during August totaled 2.03 million, 6 percent above 2004 but 2 percent below 2003. **Other disappearance** totaled 53,000 during August, 5 percent below 2004 and 12 percent below 2003.
