KANSAS CATTLE ON FEED DOWN 4%

MANHATTAN, Kan. February 24, 2023 - Kansas feedlots, with capacities of 1,000 or more head, contained 2.45 million cattle on feed on February 1, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. This inventory was down 4% from last year.

Placements during January totaled 500,000 head, up 4% from 2022.

Fed cattle marketings for the month of January totaled 430,000 head, up 2% from last year.

Other disappearance during January totaled 10,000 head, unchanged from last year.
