KANSAS CATTLE ON FEED DOWN 2%

MANHATTAN, Kan. March 17, 2023 - Kansas feedlots, with capacities of 1,000 or more head, contained 2.46 million cattle on feed on March 1, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. This inventory was down 2% from last year.

Placements during February totaled 425,000 head, down 1% from 2022.

Fed cattle marketings for the month of February totaled 405,000 head, down 10% from last year.

Other disappearance during February totaled 10,000 head, unchanged from last year.
