## KANSAS CATTLE ON FEED DOWN 2%

MANHATTAN, Kan. May 19, 2023 - Kansas feedlots, with capacities of 1,000 or more head, contained 2.44 million cattle on feed on May 1, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. This inventory was down 2% from last year.

Placements during April totaled 420,000 head, down 2% from 2022.

Fed cattle marketings for the month of April totaled 400,000 head, down 11% from last year.

Other disappearance during April totaled 10,000 head, unchanged from last year.
