KANSAS MILK PRODUCTION

MANHATTAN, Kan. April 19, 2023 - Milk production in Kansas during March 2023 totaled 369 million pounds, up 5% from March 2022, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. The average number of milk cows was 179,000 head, 8,000 head more than March 2022. Milk production per cow averaged 2,060 pounds.
