KANSAS MILK PRODUCTION

MANHATTAN, Kan. February 21, 2024 - Milk production in Kansas during January 2024 totaled 353 million pounds, down 1% from January 2023, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. The average number of milk cows was 174,000 head, 1,000 head less than January 2023. Milk production per cow averaged 2,030 pounds.
