KANSAS MILK PRODUCTION

MANHATTAN, Kan. March 20, 2024 - Milk production in Kansas during February 2024 totaled 328 million pounds, down slightly from February 2023, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. The average number of milk cows was 172,000 head, 6,000 head less than February 2023. Milk production per cow averaged 1,905 pounds.
