Subsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 0 percent short, 43 percent adequate, and 57 percent surplus.

In Delaware, there were 5 days suitable for fieldwork. Topsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 3 percent short, 55 percent adequate, and 42 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 2 percent short, 51 percent adequate, and 47 percent surplus.
