According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Maryland, there were 7 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, May 23, 2021. Topsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 20 percent short, 41 percent adequate, and 39 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 8 percent short, 53 percent adequate, and 39 percent surplus.

In Delaware, there were 7.0 days suitable for fieldwork. Topsoil moisture supplies were 22 percent very short, 63 percent short, 14 percent adequate, and 1 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 4 percent very short, 40 percent short, 53 percent adequate, and 3 percent surplus.
