Subsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 5 percent short, 91 percent adequate, and 4 percent surplus. In Delaware, there were 5 days suitable for fieldwork. Topsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 1 percent short, 88 percent adequate, and 1 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 16 percent short, 84 percent adequate, and 0 percent surplus.
