According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Maryland, there were 5.5 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, June 6, 2021. Topsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 9 percent short, 91 percent adequate, and 0 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 8 percent short, 92 percent adequate, and 0 percent surplus. In Delaware, there were 4.5 days suitable for fieldwork. Topsoil moisture supplies were 5 percent very short, 8 percent short, 81 percent adequate, and 6 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 2 percent very short, 18 percent short, 78 percent adequate, and 2 percent surplus.
