According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Maryland, there were 6.0 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, June 27, 2021. Topsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 8 percent short, 80 percent adequate, and 12 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 1 percent very short, 8 percent short, 78 percent adequate, and 13 percent surplus.

In Delaware, there were 6.0 days suitable for fieldwork. Topsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 30 percent short, 69 percent adequate, and 1 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 8 percent short, 92 percent adequate, and 0 percent surplus.
