According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Maryland, there were 6.0 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, July 18, 2021. Topsoil moisture supplies were 2 percent very short, 62 percent short, 28 percent adequate, and 8 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 3 percent very short, 57 percent short, 35 percent adequate, and 5 percent surplus.

In Delaware, there were 6.5 days suitable for fieldwork. Topsoil moisture supplies were 3 percent very short, 25 percent short, 70 percent adequate, and 2 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 8 percent short, 91 percent adequate, and 1 percent surplus.
