According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Maryland, there were 4 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, July 10, 2022. Topsoil moisture supplies were 6 percent very short, 8 percent short, 64 percent adequate, and 22 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 5 percent very short, 11 percent short, 55 percent adequate, and 29 percent surplus.

In Delaware, there were 5 days suitable for fieldwork. Topsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 21 percent short, 72 percent adequate, and 7 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 15 percent short, 85 percent adequate, and 0 percent surplus.
