According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Maryland, there were 6 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, July 25, 2022. Topsoil moisture supplies were 2 percent very short, 22 percent short, 74 percent adequate, and 2 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 2 percent very short, 16 percent short, 82 percent adequate, and 0 percent surplus.

In Delaware, there were 6 days suitable for fieldwork. Topsoil moisture supplies were 5 percent very short, 55 percent short, 36 percent adequate, and 4 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 41 percent short, 53 percent adequate, and 6 percent surplus.
