According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Maryland, there were 7 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, September 4, 2022. Topsoil moisture supplies were 25 percent very short, 28 percent short, 46 percent adequate, and 1 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 32 percent very short, 23 percent short, 44 percent adequate, and 1 percent surplus.

In Delaware, there were 6.5 days suitable for fieldwork. Topsoil moisture supplies were 18 percent very short, 81 percent short, 1 percent adequate, and 0 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 38 percent very short, 62 percent short, 0 percent adequate, and 0 percent surplus.
