According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Maryland, there were 6.5 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, September 25, 2022. Topsoil moisture supplies were 1 percent very short, 38 percent short, 60 percent adequate, and 1 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 2 percent very short, 36 percent short, 61 percent adequate, and 1 percent surplus.

In Delaware, there were 6.5 days suitable for fieldwork. Topsoil moisture supplies were 24 percent very short, 37 percent short, 35 percent adequate, and 4 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 47 percent very short, 12 percent short, 40 percent adequate, and 1 percent surplus.
