According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Maryland, there were 5 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, October 2, 2022. Topsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 3 percent short, 79 percent adequate, and 18 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 2 percent short, 81 percent adequate, and 17 percent surplus.

In Delaware, there were 4 days suitable for fieldwork. Topsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 0 percent short, 82 percent adequate, and 18 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 51 percent very short, 4 percent short, 37 percent adequate, and 8 percent surplus.
