According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Maryland, there were 4 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, October 9, 2022. Topsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 0 percent short, 88 percent adequate, and 12 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 0 percent short, 95 percent adequate, and 5 percent surplus.

In Delaware, there were 3.5 days suitable for fieldwork. Topsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 3 percent short, 79 percent adequate, and 18 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 42 percent very short, 14 percent short, 36 percent adequate, and 8 percent surplus.
